Roof Observations:

1. The Roofing Contractor is on site at the time of the observations.

2. Today's Applications: Building 5-15 35 SQ Upper Level

a. The Roofing Contractor has applied the 28 gauge pre painted drip edge along the eaves and rakes.

b. The Roofing Contractor is in the process of applying the self-adhered eave protector along the

eaves at 36" onto the roofs field – the eave protector has been run parallel with the eaves. c. The synthetic underlayment felt Titanium UDL over the roofs field is being applied.

The underlayment felt has been run parallel with the eaves.

d. The Roofing Contractor at the time of the observations is in the process of applying the BP starter strips along the eaves and the rakes.

e. The Roofing Contractor is in the process of applying the Legacy SBS Malarkey shingles at five to six roofing nails per unit.

f. Five neoprene gaskets and five exhaust vents have been installed.

3. Building 19-29:

- a. Ridge caps to be extended to the end of the ridges.
- b. Hip caps to be installed over the lower levels.
- c. Two window bays in the back to receive new roofing system.

d. Roofing materials in the back and front of the building to be removed and placed at the designated roofing parking areas.

- 4. Building 32-40:
- a. Ridge vents/caps and the hip caps to be installed.

Concerns/Issues:

1. Units 11,13 and 15 leaks have occurred during last nights hail storm.

a. Unit 13 – stained ceiling adjacent to the chandeliers, on the neon's over the kitchen and on the bathroom ceiling.

b. Units 11 visible water leakage over the windows in the leaving room.

c. Units 15 the owner not on site during my time of the observations, but according to the board they had water leakage too.

d. According to the Roofing Contractor the attic insulation appears to be dry.
